Become a Funded Assistance Site (AS)

The Assistance Site Program was established to provide funding to organizations throughout Colorado to provide education, outreach and application assistance to customers seeking health coverage through Connect for Health Colorado. Selected organizations are awarded a two-year contract with an annual work plan and budget approval. Sites are required to meet goals and complete timely reporting.

New Assistance Sites may apply once every two years during our application period, beginning in March, for two-year contracts to start at the beginning of the applicable Fiscal Year (July 1).

Become a Certified Application Counselor (CAC) designated Organization

The Certified Application Counselor Program engages organizations to support our efforts to provide Coloradans additional access to health literacy education and affordable health coverage. It is an opportunity for health care providers and organizations who already perform application assistance for health coverage programs to become Designated Organizations (CAC locations) with Connect for Health Colorado. These sites offer application assistance and help individuals and families enroll in health insurance.
